



DHS may release the alien on bond or grant parole; non-arriving asylum seekers eligible for custody review with Immigration Judge

If positive credible fear demonstrated, removal proceedings under INA § 240

If fear, ICE detention and USCIS credible fear interview

Detained and immediate removal from the U.S. unless fear of return

Expedited Removal

Customs and Border Protection

MPP Plus INA § 240 Proceedings

Hearings in U.S. border courts

Return asylum seeker to Mexico for the duration of their immigration proceedings

Immigration Court hearings – May be represented by counsel; apply for relief; appeal to BIA; seek judicial review of final order of removal

Release into the U.S., often with ankle monitor

INA § 240 Proceedings ("normal" Immigration Court proceedings)

Removal to Guatemala (or Honduras or ES) to pursue asylum there
